

Join Lok Satta to transform society: DVVS Varma

Lok Satta Party State Working President D. V. V. S. Varma today appealed to youth and all those who have shunned politics marked by dynastic and family rule and money power to utilize the Lok Satta as a platform for transforming society.

Addressing a gathering at the party headquarters to mark the celebration of Gandhi jayanthi and the party's fifth anniversary, Mr. Varma said that Dr. Jayaprakash Narayan had decided to quit as State party President to create room for new forces to lead the party.
